

RENEWAL OF THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
ON
THE CO-OPERATION IN INDUSTRIAL PROPERTY
BETWEEN
MINISTRY OF INDUSTRY & HANDICRAFT (“MIH”)
AND
INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY OFFICE OF SINGAPORE (“IPOS”)

The Ministry of Industry & Handicraft (“**MIH**”) of the Kingdom of Cambodia and the Intellectual Property Office of Singapore (“**IPOS**”) of the Republic of Singapore, desiring to further develop the co-operation arrangements between MIH and IPOS in order to meet the challenges of this century, and also to promote economic exchange between Cambodia and Singapore, as provided in the Memorandum of Understanding on the Co-operation in Industrial Property signed on 20 January 2015 (“**Memorandum of Understanding**”), have come to the following understanding:

The term of the Memorandum of Understanding shall be extended by another five (5) years from the day following the date of its expiry.

The Memorandum of Understanding shall henceforth be deemed to refer to the Memorandum of Understanding as amended by this Renewal of the Memorandum of Understanding (“**Renewal**”). Except as set forth in this Renewal, the Memorandum of Understanding shall remain in full force and effect.

This Renewal is made in four (4) originals of identical content, two (2) in English and two (2) in Khmer. In the case of any conflict or divergence of interpretation between the English and Khmer texts of this Renewal, the English text will prevail.


